RE-RUN OF A NOTE FROM MRS. WILKINSON

Beginning in February we will be catching up on registration fees that were not charged yet for many students for the 2017-18 school year (assembly fees, technology/curriculum fees, milk, etc.). We thought it would be easier to spread out the costs seeing as these costs should have been billed early in the year. Each week beginning February 5th, charges will be posted on FACTS for families where charges are due. The schedule is as follows:

READY TO REAPPLY (OR APPLY) FOR A VOUCHER??

New and returning students may begin applying for a voucher to attend Concordia beginning **TOMORROW**. The application period will continue through February 20. The process requires the parent to complete an online application (<https://apps4.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/Login/Login.aspx>) and submit income information (new students only) along with residency documentation (all students) brought to the school between Feb. 1 – Feb. 20



CONTINUING VOUCHER STUDENTS must reapply and provide residency documentation in February to be assured of retaining the seat they currently hold at Concordia. Opportunities for families to reapply or make application at the school with assistance will be held on:

- Fri., February 2, from 12:00 – 4:00 p.m.
- Mon., February 5 from 7:30– 8:30 a.m.
- Thurs, February 8 from 4:30 – 5:30 p.m.
- Tues. Feb. 13th from 4:30 – 5:30 p.m.
- Sat. Feb. 17 from 10 a.m. – NOON
- Mon. Feb. 19 from 7:30 – 8:30 a.m.

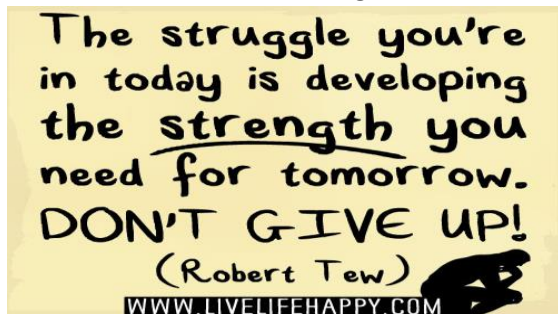
