
REGISTRATION - PART TWO!

From there go to Family Information – choose the link that says Go to FACTS (not the Facts Financial Aid link). From here you will be given options one for tuition paying and a separate for RPCP voucher families. RPCP families will choice Invoice only at this time. Tuition paying families will have the option to choose from Bank Account, Credit Card or Invoice. Once this is set up you will receive a pending notification until the office acknowledges admission.
