## REGISTRATION UPDATE

A thank you to those who have already completed setting up their payment plan through ParentsWeb. We still have many families who need to complete this process. We would like to have this complete before school is out. **This is for ALL families.** Here's all you need to do: You must sign into your ParentsWeb account under RenWeb. (You used RenWeb to complete your online enrollment previously.) From there go to Family Information – choose the link that says Go to FACTS (not the Facts Financial Aid link). From here you will be given options: one for tuition paying and a separate for RPCP voucher families. RPCP families will choice Invoice only at this time. Tuition paying families will have the option to choose from Bank Account, Credit Card or Invoice. Once this is set up you will receive a pending notification until the office acknowledges admission. **If you have not set up your ParentsWeb account or need assistance with this process in any way, please contact the school office ASAP.**
