KEEP IN MIND

School Board Policy requires our office to suspend child care services for students who have accounts that are two or more months past due. READY TO REAPPLY (OR APPLY) FOR A VOUCHER??

New and returning students may begin applying for a voucher to attend Concordia beginning **FRIDAY**. The application period runs Feb.1 through Feb. 20. The process requires the parent to complete an online application (go to: www.dpi.wi.gov/choice). Then be sure to submit income information (new students only) along with residency documentation (all students) brought to the school between Feb. 1-20. Call the office with ANY questions or to arrange an appointment for assistance.



CONTINUING VOUCHER STUDENTS must reapply and provide residency documentation in February to be assured of retaining the seat they currently hold at Concordia.
