ONLINE GRADEBOOK ACCESS FOR YOU

Parents of students in grades 2 – 8 can use their ParentsWeb Username and Password to access graded student assignments and progress on a weekly basis. Grades are updated and posted every Wednesday. It's easy to login. Simply go to www.renweb.com and click on the blue button in the upper right-hand corner. From the drop down choices there, choose ParentsWeb Login. Provide our District Code (CC-WI) and your Username and Password. (This was established when you applied and enrolled online.) Under School Information, you will find: Weekly Summary of Progress, Grades, Attendance, Schedules and more! For questions regarding grades or homework for a specific subject, be sure to contact the teacher for that subject.
