BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CARE (\$3.75 PER HOUR)

Before School Care is available daily from 6:45 - 8:25 a.m. After School Care is available immediately following dismissal until 6:15 p.m. Afternoon care for our Preschool 3-year-old students and 4K students attending the morning session is offered beginning at 12:00 p.m. Anyone desiring childcare will need to sign up the week prior to care, using Signup Genius.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

School is officially dismissed at **3:55 pm** for PK4 - 8 students. Three-year-old Preschool is dismissed at NOON daily. Please be prompt in picking up your child(ren). Those children not picked up by 4:00PM (PK4 – 8) will be placed into the After School Care program and billed for this service.

DRESS CODE The student's dress should reflect good judgment and moderation. Shorts may be worn until October 31st. Tank tops, ripped jeans, and flip flops are not permitted.

SPIRIT DAYS Every Friday the students and staff are encouraged to wear our school colors; red, black, and white or Concordia spirit wear. Show your school spirit - please participate! On occasion, we will also support our local teams by holding Packer, Badger, and Brewers apparel days. Gear up!
