PLEASE BRING ACCOUNTS CURRENT

There are still several second quarter progress reports waiting to be picked up in the office. Please take care of any outstanding childcare bills or tuition payments in order to help us pay our bills and bring your account up to date.

KEEP IN MIND

School Board Policy requires our office to suspend childcare services for students who have accounts that are two or more months past due. A payment of 50% or better must be made prior to the next billing statement to allow childcare services to continue. Please be sure to bring your account current to avoid loss of services.

The process requires the parent to complete an online application (go to: www.dpi.wi.gov/choice). Then be sure to submit income information (new students only) along with residency documentation (all students) emailed or brought to the school between Feb. 1-22. Call the office with ANY questions.



CONTINUING VOUCHER STUDENTS must reapply and provide residency documentation in February to be assured of retaining the seat they currently hold at Concordia.
