5 MORE WAYS TO HELP YOUR CHILD BUILD A GROWTH MINDSET

Even if your child has a fixed mindset now, the good news is that mindsets can change. Here are some steps you can take to encourage a growth mindset.

- 1. Provide healthy snacks and balanced meals with whole grains, fruits, vegetables, low-fat dairy, and lean protein. Follow the USDA's MyPlate guidelines every day to make sure your child gets proper nutrition.
- 2. Help your child manage the emotions that go along with learning, such as stress and frustration. Be there to listen and talk without judgment.
- 3. Give targeted praise for effort and not intelligence. (Tips on this will follow next week!)
- 4. Make sure your child gets enough sleep. Kids 6 to 13 should get 9 to 11 hours of sleep a night.
- 5. Show that you love learning, enjoy challenges, and work hard for what you want. Talk about mistakes you make and lessons you learn.

Try focusing on these 5 this week.
