PREVENTING A FALSE GROWTH MINDSET

Last week we were reminded by Dr. Carol Dweck, the American professor and researcher who discovered growth mindset that it's not just effort but strategy that is important in learning...so support the student in finding another strategy as needed. For example, if your child seems to be working hard but not making progress, praising the effort won't be effective. Instead, encourage your child to ask for help and use available resources in order to make progress.

Dr. Dweck mentions that no one has a growth mindset in all things. Look for things that trigger our fixed mindset such as being outside of a comfort zone or noticing how easy things come for somebody else. Try to aware of what is happening, so you don't get too fixed and give up! Remind your child our brains won't grow if we don't try hard things. Step in then and ask how you can help.
