## KIDS & STRESS – PART 2

Fiona Swanson's article (from Mayo's Foundation for Medical Education and Research) reminds us that while all stress cannot be eliminated for our children there are strategies that can help prevent excess stress from affecting their lives. Swanson published eight ways parents and other caregivers can help. Establishing and keeping routines is key. (#1)

During the pandemic, many children's activities were disrupted. Returning to previous favorite activities or trying a new one as soon as circumstances permit is also recommended. (#2)

Also important is finding ways to laugh with the kids. Watching comedies, telling jokes, playing games, and helping each other find the humor in daily life activates and relieves the body's stress response. A good laugh can go a long way! (#3)
