KIDS & STRESS – PART 3

Helping children cope with stress may be more challenging these days, it's true. Chasing away some of that stress can be accomplished through some pretty simple day to day activities. Here are a couple more tips from Fiona Swanson's article, Strategies for Stressed Kids. (Tips #1-3 in previous two newsletters)

#4 – **Play as a family**! Get physical with your kids and find ways to play as a family. Put on music and dance in the kitchen, go for a bike ride after dinner or play games as a family.

#5 – **Ensure they eat and sleep well.** Make sure that your children's diet includes a mix of fruit and vegetables, whole grains, and lean proteins to keep them full and focused. A lack of sleep can trigger overreaction or emotional outbursts, so follow a bedtime routine to make sure your children get enough sleep each night.
