KIDS & STRESS – PART 4

Here are the final few helpful tips from Fiona Swanson's article, *Strategies for Stress Kids*. (Tips #1-5 in previous newsletters.)

#6 – **Practice Deep Breathing Together** – Deep breathing is a great way to reduce stress levels. Help our children practice by take deep breaths in for a count of five seconds, hold for two seconds and release to a count of five seconds. If your child feels anxious, try this simple exercise to unstick the mind from the worry setting.

#7 — Enlist help from their teachers - Take the opportunity to check in with your child's teachers. Ask how they are doing, if they are making friends or if the teacher is noticing any problems between your children and other students. Often, children won't tell their parents about issues they have at school, as they may feel embarrassed. Teachers and school staff can be your eyes and ears when your child is not with you.

#8 – Manage your mental health – It's hard to be an effective parent if you struggle with your mental health. Take steps to keep stress at bay in your life.

If you find that your child's behavior persists or is worsening, consult your pediatrician.
