DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

School is officially dismissed at **3:55 pm** for PK4 - 8 students. Three-year-old Preschool is dismissed at NOON daily. Please be prompt in picking up your child(ren). Those children not picked up by 4:00PM (PK4 – 8) will placed into the After School Care program and billed for this service.

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CARE (\$3.75 PER HOUR)

Before School Care is available daily from 6:45 - 8:30 a.m. After School Care is available immediately following dismissal until 6:15 p.m. Anyone desiring childcare will need to sign up the week prior to care, using the Signup Genius link provided by email at the end of each week.

FREE MILK AVAILABLE

Please return the application that was sent home earlier this week if you qualify based on household size and income. Applications must be submitted by Sept. 30th. However, if your eligibility changes during the year you may pick up or submit an application at any time. Milk is available twice a day for PK4 – 8.
