Faith and Holy Cross members that attend worship a minimum of two services per month are considered “members in good standing” and are eligible to receive a considerable tuition discount. Families that do not meet this requirement are reminded that they will be assessed the non-member rate. Per policy as found in the Parent-Student Handbook on p. 12, the regular rate will be retroactive to the beginning of the year. Once membership in good standing is reestablished as determined by the church, the discounted rate can be reinstated. A: No. Only Law Enforcement can carry/possess a weapon legally within the school.

Q: Do we have a direct connection to the Sturtevant PD if there were to be an incident?

A: Yes. The 911 Racine County Communication Center would dispatch the Sturtevant Police Department immediately.
