EXCESSIVE TARDIES AND ABSENCES

Wisconsin Statute Sec. 118.15(1)(a) requires children to be regular in school attendance. According to State law, a student is considered truant if he/she is absent without an acceptable excuse for all or part of the school day. Habitual truancy (more than 5 unexcused absences for any part of the day) can result in a fine of up to \$500. If your child is going to be absent, please phone the school office prior to the start of the school day. The school office phone number is (262)884-0991, ext. 112 (the attendance line). If a call is not received, the child must be marked truant (Absent Unexcused). **Ongoing** accumulation of unexcused tardies/absences will be reported to the proper authorities, as required by law. Please review the student-Parent Handbook, p.13, for more information on notifications of absences/tardies and meetings with the principal.

SCHOOL SAFETY MENTIONS – PART 5

MORE safety information shared at the PLT meeting in September:

Q: What security features are in place?

A: In addition to electronic security doors, the school uses a indoor/outdoor camera monitoring system, a school-wide public announcement system for efficient communication, and portable radios in every

classroom. Frequent training and visits from the Racine County Sheriff's Department and the Sturtevant Police Department also equip our faculty with regular practice in crisis management and raises awareness of best practices. Plain talk is used when a crisis exists (or a drill is held) so communication is clear.

WHAT ARE...

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS?

There are three basic types of law in the Bible: The Civil Law, which relates to the governing of the Children of Israel during the Old Testament age; the Ceremonial Law, which deals with how God's Old Testament people were to worship and offer their sacrifices to God; and the Moral Law, which tells us how we are to live our lives as God's people. The Civil Law and the Ceremonial Law apply only to God's Old Testament people. The Moral Law applies to all people of every age.

The essence of Moral Law is the Ten Commandments. God gave the Ten Commandments to the Children of Israel at Mt. Sinai after He had delivered them from slavery in Egypt (Exodus 20: 1-17). The Ten Commandments can be divided into two parts or "tables." The First Table (Commandments 1 to 3) deals with our relationship with God and is summed up by Jesus in Matthew 22: 37-38: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and This is the great and first with all your mind. commandment." The Second Table (Commandments 4 to 10) deals with my relationship with my neighbor, and is summed up by Jesus in Matthew 22: 39-40: "And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as you love yourself. On these two commandments depend all the law and the prophets."
