### **EXCESSIVE TARDIES AND ABSENCES**

Wisconsin Statute Sec. 118.15(1)(a) requires children to be regular in school attendance. According to State law, a student is considered truant if he/she is absent without an acceptable excuse for all or part of the school day. Habitual truancy (more than 5 unexcused absences for any part of the day) can result in a fine of up to \$500. **If your child is going to be absent, please phone the school office prior to the start of the school day. The school office phone number is (262)884-0991, ext. 112 (the attendance line).** If a call is not received, the child must be marked truant (Absent Unexcused). **Ongoing accumulation of unexcused tardies/absences will be reported to the proper authorities, as required by law.**

## THIS WE BELIEVE...

### WHAT IS SIN?

Sin is disobeying God by doing what God forbids or failing to do what God commands. It is God who determines what is sin, not you or me. But sin is more than just what we do or don't do. Sin is being alienated from God. Sin is always sin in the light of one's relationship with God. Sin is sin because it is against God's will, not because it goes against the standards of society, and the gravest consequence of sin is that it separates the sinner from God.

There are two basic kinds of sin: original sin (the sinful condition with which we are all born) and actual sin (the sins we actually commit as a result of our sinful nature).

Sin affects our bodies with sickness and death (Romans 6:23). Sin affects our minds with fear and worry (Genesis 3:10). Sin affects our relationship with God. It separates us from God (Romans 8:7). Sin affects our relationship with other people, causing hatred, strife, war, and every other kind of problem in interpersonal relationships. Sin affects our relationship with the created order (Genesis 3: 17-19). The eternal consequence of sin is hell, being eternally cut off from God. God does not “send” people to hell; man himself does that through his sin and unbelief.
