THIS WE BELIEVE... "WHAT IS A SACRAMENT?"

The word "sacrament" is not a Biblical term. The closest we come to it in the Bible is the Greek word mysterion – "mystery" (1 Corinthians 4:1 – "This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.") In the Lutheran Church, we understand a Sacrament to have the following characteristics: (1) A Sacrament is commanded by God. God has instituted (established) these actions and commanded us to do them. (2) In a Sacrament God unites His Word and promise to a visible sing (water, bread, wine). (3) In a Sacrament, it is God who is at work, offering and giving forgiveness of sins and all the other spiritual blessings that Jesus has obtained for us by His death and resurrection. According to our Lutheran understanding, there are two Sacraments - Baptism and the Lord's Supper.
