THIS WE BELIEVE... "WHAT IS HOLY COMMUNION?"

"Holy Communion (also called the Sacrament of the Altar, the Lord's Supper or the Eucharist) is "the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ under the bread and wine, instituted by Christ Himself for us Christians to eat and to drink" (Luther's Small Catechism). In this Sacrament Jesus gives us His body and blood to eat and to drink. He does so under the forms of bread and wine. When we come to Holy Communion with repentant and believing hearts, Jesus assures us that our sins are forgiven, our faith is strengthened, we are empowered to live as God's people, and we have fellowship both with Christ and with one another.

It is faith alone which makes us worthy to receive the Lord's Supper. To come to the Lord's Table without such faith is to come in an unworthy manner and is thus a sin. This is one of the main reasons why we in the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod practice Closed Communion and allow only those who share this faith with us to come to the Sacrament.
