We receive this gift of God's grace by trusting that Jesus is our Savior from sin and death . . . that He died on the cross for us to make full payment for our sins. We also sometimes use the term "grace" to describe the ability that God gives us to believe in Him and do His will. "Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need" (Hebrews 4:16).
