THIS WE BELIEVE... HOW IS A HYMN DIFFERENT THAN A SONG?

When St. Paul urges us to praise God "with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs" (Colossians 3:16), the terms "hymns" and "songs" are virtually synonymous. There are two instances where these words do have a different meaning: (1) A hymn is spiritual and a song is secular. Joy to the World is a hymn; Jingle Bells is a song. (2) A hymn is more traditional, while songs are more contemporary. A hymn like A Mighty Fortress has more theological substance than a song like I've Got the Joy, Joy, Joy, Joy Down in My Heart. This is not to say that one is good and the other is bad. There is a place for both hymns and Christian songs in the life of the Church.
