THIS WE BELIEVE - WHAT IS A HYMNAL?

In its most basic form, a hymnal – or hymn book – is a book that contains sacred hymns and songs designed to be sung by both individuals and congregations. The earliest hand-written hymnals date back to the Middle Ages, and the earliest printed hymnal was published in 1501 in Prague. The first Lutheran hymnal was created by Martin Luther and Paul Speratus in 1524. It contained only eight hymns, four of them by Luther.

The current hymnal that is most widely used in the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod is *The Lutheran Service Book* (LSB), first published in 2006. Although the LSB contains over 600 hymns, it is much more than just a "hymn book." It includes five different settings of the Divine Service as well as other orders of worship. Because the LSB also contains most of the psalms, Luther's Small Catechism, and many prayers, it is an excellent resource for the individual Christian's devotional life.
