THIS WE BELIEVE - WHAT IS A LUTHER'S SMALL CATECHISM?

A catechism is a book of instruction, usually of a religious nature. Originally the term was applied to oral instruction on the principal Christian teachings ("catachesis") that was given both to children and adults in preparation for baptism or confirmation. The term later came to be used to refer to books containing such instruction. For Lutheran Christians, the *Small Catechism of Dr. Martin Luther* is the best-known catechism. Its writing was prompted by Luther's dismay over the spiritual ignorance that he encountered when he visited parishes in Saxony in the Fall of 1528. The completed *Small Catechism* was made available in an illustrated booklet in May of 1529.

In his catechism, Luther shows "in plain form" how the head of the family shall instruct his household in the main teachings of the Christian faith. These basic teachings are summed up in Six Chief Parts: The Ten Commandments, The Apostles' Creed, The Lord's Prayer, The Sacrament of Holy Baptism, Confession and Absolution, and the Sacrament of the Altar. Luther's Morning and Evening Prayers and a Table of Duties are also part of the *Small Catechism*.
