## THIS WE BELIEVE...PART TWO

Last year we addressed several questions commonly asked about Christianity. This year we will continue sharing our Christian beliefs as found in the Bible (God's Word) and Luther's Small Catechism.

**What is a creed?** A creed is a statement or confession of religious belief held in faith. The Creed, also known as The Apostles' Creed, and its meaning, can be found in Lutheran's Small Catechism. It is separated into three small parts, or articles. These articles summarize all of God's work in creation and human history as taught in the Bible. The Creed is often spoken in Lutheran worship as we share our common belief in God – as our Creator; Jesus Christ – as our Redeemer; and the Holy Spirit – as our Sanctifier. We will look at the parts of The Apostles' Creed over the next few weeks.
