## GRADEBOOK CLOSES FOR MIDTERMS

We are at the halfway point in the first quarter of our school year. At 4:00 p.m. on Friday, the gradebook will close in preparation for midterm report release next week.

**Please note:** The grades of all students will be reviewed at midterm and quarter grading periods. Students receiving an initial F or Fs, or receiving a grade point average lower than 2.0, will be placed on probation (a warning that the student must remove any F's and raise the GPA if below 2.0) until the next grade report. While on probation, that student may participate in extra-curricular activities. However, a 90-day academic probation contract will be issued which must be signed by the student, parents/guardian, teacher, and administration within 5 days.

Any student not having a 2.0 grade point average or having any Fs on two consecutive grade sheets will be declared ineligible to participate in any extra-curricular activities until a subsequent grade sheet shows a 2.0 average and no Fs.

*Please take an active role in following up on gradebook notifications regarding low or missing grades, monitoring assignment completion, study habits, and quality of work. We are here to help but rely on a partnership approach with you. Please contact your child's teacher with any questions.*

## THIS WE BELIEVE...PART TWO

Last year we addressed several questions commonly asked about Christianity. This year we will continue sharing our Christian beliefs as found in the Bible (God's Word) and Luther's Small Catechism.

**What is the Apostles' Creed?** This is a written statement that tells us the most important truths about God: who He is and what he has done for us. God is the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit – the Holy Trinity. This creed has three simple parts (articles) which sum up the divine work associated with each person: the Father (creation), the Son (redemption), and the Holy Spirit (sanctification). The Creed begins with the words "I believe", thereby stating that "I am convinced that God has made me, redeemed me, and sanctified me".

The First Article (Part 1) of The Apostles' Creed is: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.

We believe that God has made us and all creatures; that he has given us our body and soul, eyes, ears, and all our members, our reason and all our senses, and still takes care of them. *He gives us even so much more, purely out of his goodness and mercy.*

We believe that no one but God "could create heaven and earth". God created out of nothing everything that exists. Nothing exists apart from God's creation.

We will look at another part of The First Article of the Apostles' Creed next week.
