THIS WE BELIEVE...PART TWO

From then He will come to judge the living and the dead.**

It concludes (Third Article): **I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and the life everlasting. Amen.**

As fallen people, we cannot come to find God on our own so here we confess that the Holy Spirit makes us new creations by bringing us to faith in Jesus. Through His saving grace the Spirit invites us and enables us to believe in God's promise of forgiveness, through faith in Jesus who died for our sins.
