FORWARD EXAM RESULTS

Yesterday the Department of Public Instruction published the statewide results for the 2022-23 State Report Card - The Forward Exam. This report is one resource we use to reflect on our strengths and look for areas to improve in. Based on a school's score, a school receives one of five ratings, from Fails to Meet Expectations to Significantly Exceeds Expectations. Concordia scores place our school in the Meets **Expectations** rating. As we strive to exceed that rating, continued focus is being placed on math fact proficiency and application, along with written language skills. You can support these efforts by providing additional math fact practice and emphasis on writing that utilizes proper mechanics and provides details that support responses to questions. Homework support provided through the SHINE program is designed to assist with overall academic achievement, as well.

Students that attended Concordia last year and are in grades 4 – 8 are bringing home their personal results on this exam. Please ask your child to provide these to you. While this is just one measure of your child's achievement, you are encouraged to consider areas with your child for extra effort and focus to allow for continued growth. Contact your child's teacher with questions on how they can continue to assist you further.

CHRONIC LOW, LATE, OR MISSING WORK

Are you getting emails from RenWeb Support (our gradebook manager) with information on low scores or missing work for your child? Have you addressed the importance of faithful homework completion, completing work to the best of their God-given ability, and being responsible for turning work in? Please contact your child's teacher with questions! These emails are designed to provide important communication to effect change and lead to improved academic achievement. Your support is appreciated and critical to student success.
