TIME TO APPLY FOR A VOUCHER New and returning students may begin applying for a Racine Parental Choice Program voucher to attend Concordia beginning **Thursday, February 1st**. The application period runs Feb.1 through Feb. 20. The process requires the parent to complete an online application (go to: www.dpi.wi.gov/choice). Next, be sure to submit income information (new students only) along with residency documentation (all students) emailed or brought to the school between Feb. 1-20. Call the office with ANY questions.



CONTINUING VOUCHER STUDENTS must reapply and provide residency documentation in February to be assured of retaining the seat they currently hold at Concordia.
