THIS WE BELIEVE...

By Christ’s death on the cross, He accomplished salvation, providing forgiveness of sins for the entire world. 😊 Unless this good news is shared, it is of no benefit. As Christians, we gladly confess that Jesus sends His servants (US!) to proclaim this news, forgiving the sins of all who repent. God gives authority to His church on earth to forgive sins of the repentant and to withhold forgiveness of the unrepentant. This special authority or power is the **Office of the Keys**.

Why do we refer to this authority as the power of the Keys? Just as keys lock and unlock, the authority to forgive and retain sins opens and closes heaven. Christ gives two keys to His Church: One key absolves from sin and opens heaven. The other retains sins and closes heaven to those who have no regret for their sinful actions or attitudes.

Who is to be forgiven? All who repent and ask for forgiveness are to be freed of their sins.

Who is not to be forgiven? Those who do not repent and believe in Jesus Christ are not to be forgiven as long as they continue in their unbelief and do not repent.

All sinners who are sorry for their sins and trust in Christ as their Savior receive this forgiveness!
