#### THIS WE BELIEVE...

Here's a little more information to answer the question, "What will they teach my child at a Lutheran school"? It is important to us to share this information with you! (Words in parentheses below direct you to a book and verses of the Bible where you can look up where the belief we share is found.)

Lutheran schools teach about God! There is only one God, but there are three equal persons in the Holy Trinity (Matthew 28:19). God the Father is the First Person of the Trinity, the Creator of everything and everyone (Genesis 1 – 2). God the Son is the Second Person of the Trinity, the Savior, who died for our sins and rose from the dead. (2 Timothy 1:10). God the Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Trinity, the Sanctifier, who gives us faith through His Word and Sacraments (Romans 5:5).

Lutheran schools ALSO about Salvation! God created us individually and specially (Psalm 139:13). He gave us the Ten Commandments through Moses (Exodus 20: 1 – 17). God requires us to obey His Law perfectly (Matthew 5: 48). We are all sinners, unable to obey God perfectly (Ecclesiastes 7:20). God saved us from hell by Christ's sacrifice on the cross (Galatians 3: 13-14) because He loves us so much!
