The role of the Lutheran teacher was highlighted here last week. What other roles are there? Read on...

What is a Director of Christian Education (DCE)? A DCE serve as lifespan (“cradle to grave”) Christian educators who typically serve within congregations and their ministries. Areas of expertise may include teaching ESL or working with member care, missionary youth and community youth. Through their leadership and service, they teach the faith to children, youth and adults.

What is a Director of Christian Outreach (DCO)? A DCO focuses on witnessing and outreach. Through their expertise and guidance, they help congregations witness to those outside of the church to share the Gospel in a relational and evangelical way so that people may have saving faith through Jesus Christ.
