The process requires the parent to complete an online application (go to: www.dpi.wi.gov/choice). Next, be sure to submit income information (new students only) along with residency documentation (all students) emailed or brought to the school between Feb. 3-20. Call the office with ANY questions.

CONTINUING VOUCHER STUDENTS must reapply and provide residency documentation in February to be assured of retaining the seat they currently hold at Concordia.
